

“Kids in Action” Program

Please read through this pamphlet and ask any questions about the Nampa Recreation Center “Kids in Action” day camp program. The following guidelines are to help parents and children have a fun and safe experience with the program. Please keep this information for future reference.

Day Camp Philosophy:

Our philosophy focuses on creating a fun and safe environment in which your child participates in interesting activities, while developing worthwhile friendships. Supervision is provided to offer an enjoyable and safe environment.

Transportation:

Before school transportation is provided to any Nampa public school at no additional charge. After School transportation is provided from any Nampa public school for an additional fee of 50¢ per day. We ask that if this is your child's first time on the bus, that you write a letter to their teacher letting them know your child is to ride the Kids in Action bus to the Rec Center.

At the time you register, you can ask for the bus number that your child will be riding each day.

*Note:

In order for your kindergartner to ride the bus, you must fill out a transportation form at your child's school.

Snacks & Lunches:

We will provide children with one snack for after school service and two snacks for full day service. Please provide your child with a lunch or purchase a lunch through the Rec Center each day for full-day service. Meal is provided by either Blimpies, Pizza Hut or Del Taco.

Cost is \$3.50/lunch

\$16/5-punch card or \$30/10-punch card

Eligibility:

"Kids in Action" is open to all Nampa Public School students enrolled in kindergarten through fifth grade, ages 5-12 (charter and private school students will be accepted but no transportation is available before or after school. Parent's will need to arrange transportation to and from the KIA program.)

Before School Hours:

Before school hours run from 6:30am-8:30am or until the bus or van departs to your child's school. All children going to school must be at the Nampa Rec Center no later than 7:30am.

After School Hours:

2:30pm-6:30pm

Full Day:

6:30am-6:30pm

*Note:

A \$5 late pick up fee applies for each ½ hour after 6:30pm.

Registration Fees

Before School:

Pass Holder \$7/day or Non-Pass Holder \$9/day

After School:

Pass Holder \$7/day or Non-Pass Holder \$9/day

Before & After School:

Pass Holder \$10.50/day or Non-Pass Holder \$12.50/day

Full Day:

Pass Holder \$18/day or Non-Pass Holder \$20/day

After School Transportation Fee:

50¢/day

½ day (when offered by school):

Pass Holder \$11/day or Non-Pass Holder \$13.50/day

Before & ½ day (when offered by school):

Pass Holder \$14/day or Non-Pass Holder \$16.50/day

Program Policies:

Pre-registration and payment is required. A \$5 late fee will be charged if your child has not been paid for by 7pm on the day of attendance.

Accounts that reach \$100 outstanding will not be allowed to attend until the balance is paid in full.

Profile Sheets:

Please fill out a current Profile Sheet for your child every year or if there are any changes during the school year. All persons eligible to pick up your child must be listed on the profile sheet and must be 18 years of age or older. Expect to be asked to show your I.D. as we care about the safety of your child.

To Receive Credits:

If for any reason your child can not attend the KIA program on a day they are registered for, we will give you credit if we are notified by 12:30 p.m. of that specific day. You may email us at rec@cityofnampa.us or call 468-5858 to request a credit.

Credits will not roll over, you may use credits by informing the staff when you fill out a registration form at the Program Desk.

Behavior Policy:

Good behavior is always encouraged in the KIA program. Excessive disruptive or violent behavior will result in disciplinary action up to a "Strike Report" which goes home to the parent. Multiple "Strike Reports" will result in a Supervisor written Behavior Report and a meeting with the parent may be scheduled to work on an action plan to address the issue.
