### Day Camp Philosophy:

Our philosophy focuses on creating a fun, supervised and safe environment in which your child participates in interesting activities, while developing worthwhile friendships.

### Eligibility:

Kids in Action summer day camp is open to all students ages 5-12.

### Full Day Summer Service:

Full day hours run from 6:30am-6:30pm.\*

### KIA CLOSED JULY 4th

#### \*Note:

After 6:30pm, there is a \$5 late fee charged for every ½ hour your child is not picked up from the program.

### Registration Fees:

Member \$24/day  
Non-Member \$27/day

### Program Policies:

Pre-registration and payment is required. Space is limited. A \$5 late fee will be charged if your child has not been paid by the day of attendance. Accounts that reach \$100 outstanding balance will not be allowed to attend until balance is paid.

### Snacks & Lunches:

We will provide children with two snacks daily. Please provide your child with a lunch or purchase a lunch through the Rec Center each day. Meal is provided by either Subway or Pizza Hut.

Cost is \$4/lunch

\$18.25/5-punch card

or \$34.25/10-punch card

### Swimming:

Swimming will take place each day after lunch as staff to children ratio allows.

Children must be signed in by 9am on Field Trip days and have a packed lunch.

Siblings may go on trips with the younger sibling group as spots are available.

Please plan ahead for individuals who may be picking up your child from the program, such as babysitters, neighbors, or relatives. They need to be written on your child's profile sheet to be eligible to pick up your child.

**There will be no phoned-in requests taken and no one under 18 is allowed to pick up your child. I.D. will be checked.**

### To Receive Credits:

If for any reason your child cannot attend the KIA Program for a day they are registered for, we will give you credit **if we are notified by 7pm the day prior. You may cancel the day online** or call 208-468-5858 to request a credit.

Your credits can be used the next time you register for the program. **Credits will not roll over to another day without a parent or guardian filling out a KIA registration form.** Credits cannot be used without first notifying the program desk.

### Behavior Policy:

Good behavior is always encouraged in the KIA program. In the case of inappropriate or excessively disruptive behavior, children may receive a written "strike report" from the staff. Three or more strikes will result in a behavior report followed by a parent meeting with the KIA supervisor before your child will be allowed to return to the program.
